To obtain this certification, a variety of tools, such as crowbars, drills, sledgehammers and oxy-

acetylene torches are used to put the vault's ability to withstand break-in to the test. The very lightweight modular strong room panels reduce transportation costs and facilitate an easy and quick assembly. The certified lightweight solution has been specifically designed to address strong room projects for which a lower floor loading restriction is imposed – such as upstairs or in an historic building, and where standard vaults cannot be installed.

Gunnebo's high-security strong rooms are constructed by combining at least one vault door with modular wall, floor and ceiling panels. The components are mounted together for a strong room that maximises available space, whether in a new or in an existing construction.

Customisable design



- Interior finished with primed surface; exterior finished with steel (optional)

The door is certified as Grade V and VI by the European Certification Board Security Systems (ECB-S), in accordance with the EN 1143-1 standard. Seven and thirteen active front bolts and two relockers make sure that this door is an impenetrable gate to protect valuables. The very lightweight door reduces transportation costs and facilitates assembly. At the same time, the Centurion light-weight vault door is designed to optimise simplicity and accessibility for a solution that is user-friendly and easy to operate.
